

DIRECTIONS TO DISTRICT VI COMPETITIVE PLAYING LEAGUE FIELDS

49'er/AUBURN

Railhead Park: I-80 east past Auburn. Take Highway 49 exit, go right to Lincoln Way. Right on Lincoln Way. Left on Auburn-Folsom Road. Go to Pacific Avenue. Left on Pacific Avenue about three blocks to Railhead Park (on left).

Meadow -Vista Park: I-80 east to Meadow Vista exit. Turn left and go back over freeway. Proceed approximately 2½ miles to Meadow Vista and park is on the left.

Regional Park: I-80 east to Grass Valley/Placerville exit. Turn left to Grass Valley and go approximately 3½ miles to town of Auburn. Turn left at Quartz. Turn right one block and follow 2 blocks and park is on right.

ANDERSON UNITED

Anderson River Park: I-5 exit at Anderson. East on Balls Ferry Road for 3 blocks to Stingy Road (at "T" in road). Left on Stingy Road, 3 blocks to Rupert Road. Right on Rupert. Park at end of Rupert.

Anderson Middle School: I-5 exit at 273 at the Factory Outlets Mall. Continue 273 to light at North Street. Left on North Street, immediate left on Frontage Road. Right on Ferry Street. Anderson Middle School is ½ mile on left.

Meadow Lane School: I-5 exit at Anderson. East on Balls Ferry Road. Meadow Lane School is on the left at the first stop sign.

BUTTE UNITED

Chico Senior High School: Take Highway 99 north from Sacramento to Chico. Exit East First Ave. and Turn Left. Turn Left on Esplanade. Turn right on Sacramento Ave. Fields are behind the School.

Bidwell Junior High School: Take Highway 99 north from Sacramento to Chico. Exit East Avenue and go right. Approximately 4 signals turn right on North Avenue. Field are located in far right of school grounds behind Pleasant Valley Recreation Center.

Wildwood Park: Take Highway 99 north from Sacramento to Chico. Exit East Avenue go approximately 3 miles. East Avenue turns into Manzanita Avenue (and may be approached from Highway 32/Bruce Road). Take entrance to Upper Bidwell Park

CAPITAL VALLEY

Cherry Island: From the south, take Business 80 to Watt Avenue North exit. Proceed on Watt Avenue to U Street. Turn left on U Street. The fields are on the right. Check the board for the exact location of field number.

From the north, take I-80 to Antelope exit, go west on Antelope (or to the right coming from the north), Cherry Island is on the right.

Hamilton Street Park: Traveling on I-80, exit at Madison Avenue to Right. Continue on Madison Avenue to Auburn Blvd. - Right. Go about (3) miles down Auburn Blvd. to Myrtle Avenue. Hamilton Street Park is at the end of the road.

DAVIS

Davis #1, #2 and #3: From Sacramento take 1-80 West to Mace Blvd. exit. Turn left over freeway. Turn left at stop light (Childs Road). Follow frontage road past car dealers for about 1.5 miles. Turn right on road 105D at the sign for the DYSL soccer fields. (Fields can be seen on the right from the frontage road.)

Pioneer: From Sacramento take 1-80 West to Mace Blvd. exit. Turn left over freeway. Turn left at stop light (Childs Road). Turn right on El Cemonte, the first cross street, then left on Swingle Drive, the second cross street. This will take you right into Pioneer Park.

EL DORADO

Ponderosa High School: Take Hwy. 50 to the first Shingle Springs exit, which is also for Ponderosa Road. Go left at the stop sign back over the freeway. Proceed down Ponderosa Road approximately ¼ of a mile. School will be on your right. Take first entrance, fields will be by baseball field and to the left of the football stadium, If you have any questions call Brian Frazier at 941-1636.

ELK GROVE

Underwood Park: Take Highway 99 South to Laguna/Bond Road exit. Turn left and go back over the freeway. The park is ½ mile down Bond Road on the left.

Bartholomew Park: I-5 to Laguna Boulevard Exit. East on Laguna Boulevard past Town Hall to Babson. Turn right and go 1/4 mile on Babson. Right on Bendix and go 3/4 mile. Park is next to Joseph Sims Middle School.

FAIRFIELD - SUISUN

Octo Inn Soccer Park: I-80 towards San Francisco to Travis Boulevard exit. Right at the lights. Right at Oliver Road. Right onto Woodcreek Drive. Complex on the right.

Amy Blanc Elementary School: I-80 towards San Francisco to Air Base Parkway exit. Go over freeway. Once on Air Base Parkway, take first left at the lights onto Heath Drive. Turn right onto Dahlia Street. Turn right onto Heather Drive. Right onto Atlantic Ave. School is on the left-hand side.

Dover Middle School: I-80 towards San Francisco to Air Base Parkway exit. Go over freeway. Once on Air Base Parkway, take the N. Texas exit. At the lights, turn right onto N. Texas. Take the first left onto East Alaska Avenue. Follow East Alaska around. School is on the right-hand side.

GOLD COUNTRY

Ready Springs: I-80 to Auburn. Exit Hwy 49 go north to Grass Valley. Turn south on Hwy 20 to Marysville. Continue 6 miles and turn left onto Penn Valley Drive. Continue 3/4 mile through stop sign. Field is on the right hand side approximately 3/10 mile past stop sign.

Clear Creek: Interstate 80 to Auburn. Exit Hwy 49 go north to Grass Valley. Turn south on Hwy 20 to Marysville. Immediately exit to McCourtney Road (Fairgrounds). Continue approximately 7 miles. School fields on right (up driveway).

MAVERICK UNITED

Margaret Polk Park: From I-5 North, passing through the City of Redding, to Shasta Dam Boulevard. Exit at Shasta Dam Boulevard. Drive through the City of Shasta, approximately 2 miles the park which will be on the left with the entrance just past the baseball fields.

NAPA

Redwood Middle School, Raiders Fields & East Field: Take Highway 80 to Highway 12. West on Highway 12 to Highway 29. North on Highway 29 (at the “Y” intersection, approximately one mile north of Highway 12, stay to the left, cross over the Napa River and continue north on Highway 29). At the 4th exit (first stop light), turn left onto

Redwood Road. There is a Union 76 station at the southwest corner of the intersection. Drive west on Redwood Road, past an Exxon station, 7/11 and retirement home. The parking lot for the Raiders' fields is on the right, just past the retirement home. For additional parking, take the next street on the right to the front of Redwood Middle School.

PLACER UNITED

Cherry Island: From the south, take Business 80 to Watt Avenue North exit. Proceed on Watt Avenue to U Street. Turn left on U Street. The fields are on the right. Check the board for the exact location of field number.

From the north, take I-80 to Antelope exit, go west on Antelope (or to the right coming from the north), Cherry Island is on the right.

Maidu Park: I-80 to Douglas Blvd. East Exit. Take Douglas Blvd. East to Rocky Ridge Road. Right on Rocky Ridge. Go 1.2 miles. Turn left into the Maidu Community Center. Left at "T" and follow road to deadend. Soccer fields are behind the softball/baseball fields.

U10 Kaseberg Park in Roseville: Take 80 to Riverside exit in Roseville. Go north on Riverside, left on Cirby, Right on Foothill, Pass Baseline Rd., go right on Rand. The park is on the right.

REDDING UNITED

Enterprise Park, Redding: From I-5 North, take Cyprus exit. Turn right (you will pass Hilltop, Churn Creek). At Victor, turn right. Approximately 3/4 mile past Hartnell, fields will be on the right.

Caldwell Park Field, Redding: From I-5 North, take exit for Hwy. 299 West. Follow 299 west to Pine Street., then turn right, Go one block and then turn left on Eureka. Go one block and then turn right on Market. (Hwy. 273 North). Make a left on Quartz Hill Road, field is 1/2 block on left.

Sequoia. Middle School: I-5 North exit Hwy. 299 West. Follow 299 west over the river get off at first off ramp past river that is Park Marina Boulevard/Convention Center. Turn left at stop sign and go over the freeway. Turn right at Butte Street. Go 1/4 mile and turn left on Sequoia Street. Fields are 1/4 mile on left past school.

Shasta Community College: I-5 North exit Hwy. 299 East. Get off at Old Oregon Trail. Turn left at stop sign and go under freeway. Take either north or south entrance to the college. Proceed to far northeast part of campus. Soccer fields are next to football stadium and track. Turn down road next to maintenance building and park on the road or in the lot.

RIVER CITY

Larchmont Park: Take Highway 50 to the Watt Avenue. North exit. Proceed on Watt Avenue to La Riviera Drive. Turn right on La Riviera Drive Proceed on La Riviera to Stansbury and turn left. Parks will be straight ahead.

Natomas High School: Interstate 5 to Truxel south, School is on corner of Truxel and San Juan.

SACRAMENTO UNITED

John F. Kennedy High School: I-5 South to Florin Road west. Follow Florin Road until Gloria Drive. Turn right. School is on the corner of Florin Road and Gloria Drive.

C.P.Huntington School: Take Highway 99 South to Fruitridge Road West. Proceed on Fruitridge Road to 24th Street. Turn left on 24th Street and proceed to Edna Street. Turn left on Edna to 26th Street. The school is at the end of Edna on 26th.

Garcia Bend Park: Take Interstate 5 South to Pocket/Meadowview Exit. Proceed right on Pocket Road approximately 2 miles. Park is on the left.

Freeport Shores: Take Interstate 5 South to Pocket/Meadowview Exit. Proceed left over Freeway. Turn right on Freeport Boulevard (2nd stop light). Park is one mile on left.

SAN JUAN

Cherry Island: From the south, take Business 80 to Watt Avenue North exit. Proceed on Watt Avenue to U Street. Turn left on U Street. The fields are on the right. Check the board for the exact location of field number. From the north, take I-80 to Antelope exit, go west on Antelope (or to the right coming from the north), Cherry Island is on the right.

TEHAMA

I-5 North. Take 2nd Corning exit. Exit on Corning Road. Go right (east) on Solano Street about 1½ miles. Take the first right after the railroad tracks. Follow road until it dead ends. Turn left on Fig Lane and go about 4 blocks. Fields are on the right.

VACAVILLE

Cooper School: From Sacramento, exit I-80 West at Leisure Town Road/Vaca Valley Parkway. At light turn left and go over the overpass. Turn right on Ulatis Road. At Christine Drive, turn left. Go past school to park on right.

Stonegate: From Sacramento, exit I-80 West at Leisure Town Road/Vaca Valley Parkway. At light turn left and go over the overpass. Turn right on Stonegate Drive. Continue on Stonegate. Park will be on left.

YUBA SUTTER

Gray Avenue Middle School, Yuba City: From Sacramento take I-5 north to Us 99 towards Yuba City. Proceed through Yuba City until you reach Bridge Street. Turn right and go two blocks. Left on Gray Avenue near Albertsons. Make an immediate left just after shopping center parking lot and prior to Gray Avenue Middle School. Soccer field is located just north of the parking lot. *Travel time 1 hour.*

Beckworth Riverfront Park, Marysville: From Sacramento take Highway 65 to Highway 70 to Marysville. After crossing the bridges into Marysville, turn left at the 3rd Street signal just prior to McDonald's. Turn left on F Street, stay to the right and enter Beckworth River Front on Bizz Johnson Drive. Follow Bizz Johnson. Drive until you see soccer fields on the left. *Travel time 1 hour.*

Faith Christian High School, Yuba City: From Sacramento take I-5 north to Us 99 towards Yuba City. Proceed through Yuba City until you reach Highway 20 signal (near Yuba City Mall). Turn left at signal and continue west about 1 mile. Right at Hooper Road exit (just past Dow Lewis motors and before the First Methodist United Church) High school campus located on the frontage road with the soccer field and parking lot located in the back (north of Highway 20). *Travel time 1 hour.*

CHERRY ISLAND SOCCER COMPLEX USE GUIDELINES

1. PLEASE remember that the Cherry Island Soccer Complex is operated by **VOLUNTEERS ONLY**. No one else other than soccer organizations are providing money for the operation and MAINTENANCE of the complex.
2. Please pick up after yourselves as there is **NO ONE PICKING UP AFTER YOU** other than other volunteers. Please remind your teams that athletic tape is **NOT BIODEGRADABLE**, so please pick it up and dispose of it properly.
3. **DO NOT USE YOUR OWN NETS**, Teams are to use the nets provided for the complex which are located in the storage room behind the snack bar and restrooms (in the same building).
4. First team of the day sets up the field (nets and corner flags). Last team takes down the field and returns the nets and flags to the storage room. If not sure, just ask. Usually there are no games scheduled to start after 4:00 PM.
5. **NO PARKING** is allowed in the red zones. That area is for emergency and official use only. You may load and unload passengers by the snack bar area, but must immediately move your vehicle upon completion. **DO NOT LEAVE VEHICLES UNATTENDED**.
6. **NO PARKING** is allowed in front of the complex along U Street to the west of the entrance. You may park along U Street to the east of the entrance. Please diagonal park to conserve space as parking is limited. You may also park on 28th Street, on the east side of the complex.
7. **NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED** other than special companion animals, i.e., seeing eye dogs, etc.
8. **NO RVs ARE ALLOWED INSIDE THE COMPLEX** in any parking areas. There is simply not enough room. RVs must park along 28th Street on the east side of the complex.
9. When field area are opened for parking, please use extreme caution so as not to destroy the turf.
10. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OR GLASS BOTTLES** are allowed at the complex.
11. No selling allowed within the complex area without an approved concession permit from District VI officials.
